

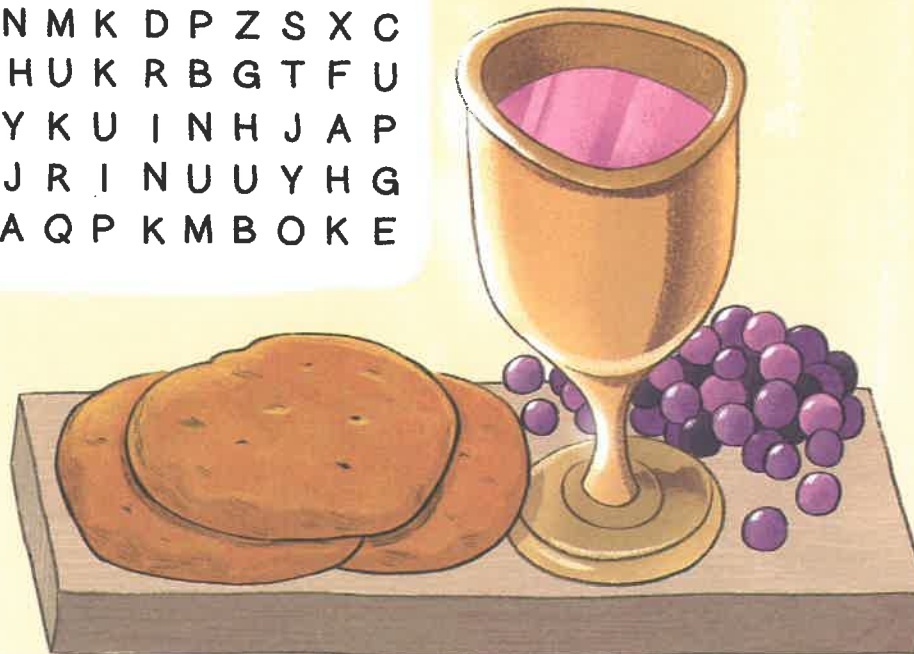

**KEY PASSAGE:** Luke 4:18

**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:**

- Why do believers share the Lord's Supper? Believers share the Lord's Supper to remember Jesus' life and death and to proclaim Him until He returns.

**BIBLE STORY:**

**THE LAST SUPPER**

- Jesus and His disciples prepared for the Passover.
- Jesus served His disciples by washing their feet.
- Jesus was giving them an example of how to serve others.
- Jesus and the disciples ate the first Lord's Supper at Passover.

**FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:**

- How else did Jesus serve people?
- What are some ways we can serve others?
- Who can we serve?

**FAMILY ACTIVITY:**

- Work with your family to make a chore chart. Explain what different chores need to be done and why it is important to serve each other by sharing the burden of housework.

**KEY PASSAGE:** Ephesians 2:8-9

**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:**

- Why did Jesus die on the cross?

- Jesus went before the governor, Pilate.
- Pilate offered to release Jesus or Barabbas.
- The people chose Barabbas and shouted for Jesus to be killed.

**FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:**

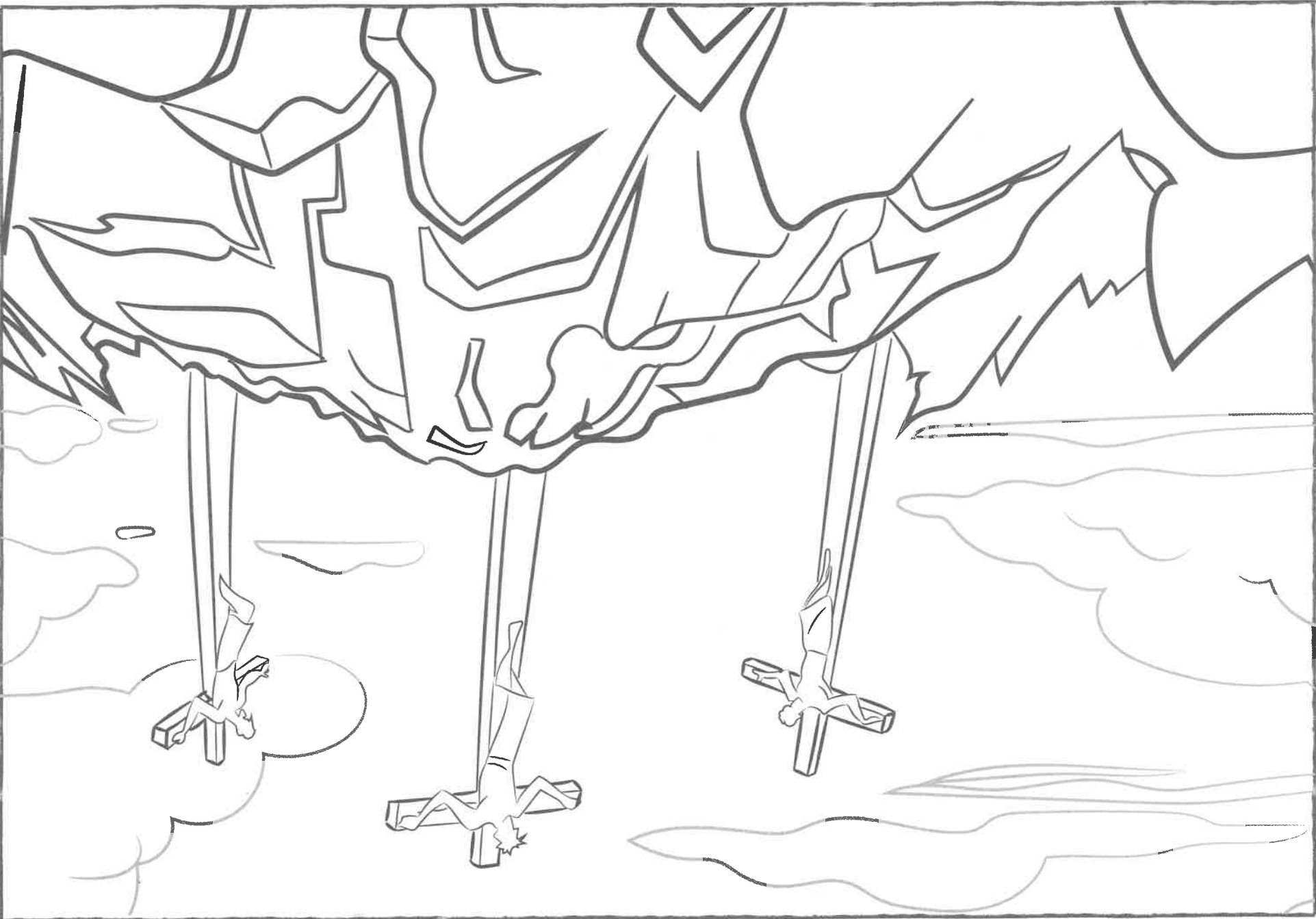
- Why were the people so angry about Jesus?

- Who can be saved by Jesus' sacrifice?

**FAMILY ACTIVITY:**

- Use dull nails, jewelry wire, and twine to make cross necklaces. Talk to your kids about the importance of Jesus' death. Encourage them to wear their necklace as a reminder to themselves and a conversation starter with friends.

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**KEY PASSAGE:** Ephesians 2:8-9

**BIG PICTURE QUESTION:**

- Why did Jesus die on the cross?  
Jesus died on the cross to save us from our sins and came back to life to show we are forgiven.

**BIBLE STORY:**

**JESUS' RESURRECTION**

- Mary and two of Jesus' disciples went to see His body Sunday morning.
- When they arrived, His body was not there!
- Jesus was resurrected on the third day.
- Jesus sent Mary to tell the disciples that He is alive.

**FAMILY DISCUSSION STARTERS:**

- Why is Jesus' resurrection so important?
- Who can we tell about Jesus' resurrection?
- How do you feel knowing that Jesus is alive?

**FAMILY ACTIVITY:**

- Cover a balloon with paper mache. When it dries, allow your kids to pop the balloon and show that the sculpture is empty, like Jesus' tomb.
